- (a) & (b) No Sir. However, the Department of Official Languages does have a website at dol.nic.in. and the Commission for Scientific & Technical Terminology has a website www.cstt.nic.in wherein different subjects terminology on the server of the National Information Centre can be assessed. Further, the Government already implements the following schemes for popularising Hindi;
- i) Teaching Hindi as a second and Foreign Language to Non- Hindi speaking Indians and foreigners through correspondence courses.
- ii) Teaching Hindi through cassettes
- iii) Dictionaries and conversational guides in Hindi and foreign Languages
- iv) Grants to Voluntary Hindi Organisations, specially to those located in Non-Hindi speaking States.
- v) Appointment and training of Hindi teachers in Non-Hindi speaking States/UTs.
- vi) Production of University Text books in Hindi.
- vii) Besides, there is a proposal to introduce first part of the "Hindi Vishwa Kosh" published by the Nagri Pracharni Sabha (Varanasi) on Internet by September, 2000.
- (c) All the above mentioned schemes have been very successful in the popularising of Hindi specially in the South and North East Regions of India.
