(a) to (c): Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) is setting up a refinery of 9 million metric tonnes per annum (MMTPA) capacity at village Abhayachandrapur near Paradip in Orissa and the project as per present schedules, is likely to be completed in August, 2003.

In addition, Letter of Intent had been issued to M/s Ashok Leyland Ltd. for a 2.0 MMTPA Lube Refinery at Paradip in Orissa.
