- (a) the number of employees in ITDC excluding the hotel employees, as on date;
- (b) whether the Government propose to rollback the retirement age from 60 years to 58 years for the employees of the India Tourism Development Corporation; and
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor?

Answer

- (a) Presently, the manpower strength in ITDC excluding the Hotels & Catering Establishments is 1793.
- (b) & (c) : The ITDC Board has accepted, in principle, the concept of rolling back the retirement age. Accordingly, ITDC has approached the Government for seeking approval.
