- (a) the number of Blood Banks in Orissa got recognition from the Union Government;
- (b) whether any financial aid for upgradation of Blood Banks has been given to Orissa; and
- (c) if so, the financial assistance provided for this purpose to the State during each of the last three years?

## **Answer**

- (a) There are 48 licensed Blood Banks in Orissa.
- (b) Yes, Sir.
- (c) The scheme is for modernisation of various level blood banks and major blood banks by supplying them blood bank equipments, besides cash assistance for Salaries of Technicians and a contingency amount for procuring reagents and other consumables. Funds have been released as follows:-

1996-97 Rs. 50.00 lakhs 1997-98 Rs. 75.00 lakhs 1998-99 Rs.100.00 lakhs

Funds have been placed at the disposal of State AIDS Cell of Government of Orissa now converted as State AIDS Control Society o Orissa.
