(a) to (c): The small scale industries in India have enough competitive strengths to withstand the impact of the phasing out of quantitative restrictions beyond April 2001. The Government is, however, laying specific emphasis on areas such as WTO sensitization, technology development, IT applications, standard and quality control, modern managerial practices and business-to-business cooperation at the domestic and international level for making our small enterprises globally competitive.
