TRAINING CAMPS FOR SMALL ENTREPRENEURS

Will the Minister of SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES AND RURAL AND AGRO INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government propose to train small-scale entrepreneurs in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if so, the extent to which such training camps has been useful;
- (d) whether any efforts have been made by the Government to have effective tie-ups with multinationals and large companies for organising training camps for these entrepreneurs; and
- (e) if so, the linkages orchestrated by the Government between its training programmes and the large players in the economy?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES AND AGRO RURAL INDUSTRIES (SMT. VASUNDHARA RAJE)

(a) to (c): Yes, Sir. The Government through various national level entrepreneurship development institutes such as the National Institute of Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development, New Delhi; the National Institute of Small Industry Extension Training, Hyderabad; the Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship, Guwahati; and the Integrated Training Centre, Nilokheri conducts various entrepreneurship development and management programmes for the small entrepreneurs. These training programmes help entrepreneurs set up and also run their enterprises successfully by adopting modern management practices.

(d) to (e): The Government is playing a pro-active role in creating linkage between small and large companies, including multinational companies, by organising general and sector specific vendor development programmes and buyer-seller-meets.
