- (a)&(b) The Gujjar Community is included in the list of Scheduled Tribes in respect ofthe State of Jammu & Kashmir and Himachal Pradesh [excluding the territories specified in sub-section 1
- (i) of section 5 of the Punjab reorganization act 1996 (31 of 1966)]. Gujjar ot gujar community is also included in the Central List of Other Backward Classes (OBCs) in the State of Himachal Pradesh (in merged area only).

Gurjar, Gujjar and Gujar communities are also included in the Central List of OBCs in the following States/Union Territories:-

(i) chandigarh - Gujjar
(ii) Delhi - Gujar, Gurjar
(iii) Haryana - Gujjar
(iv) Punjab - Gujjar
(v) Rajasthan - Gujar, Gurjar
(vi) Uttar Pradesh - Gujar
```

(c) Persons belonging to above mentioned communities of Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes (in the Central List) are getting benefits as admissible as per the guidelines laid down.
