Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of reservation provided to the other Backward Classes in Services in Jammu and Kashmir State during the last three years;
- (b) the total number of posts lying vacant in each category;
- (c) the total number of posts likely to be filled in different reserved categories during the next three years; and
- (d) the steps taken to strengthen the monitoring agency in order to safeguard the interest of persons belonging to different reserved classes?

Answer

(a)to(d) The National Backward Classes Commission Act, 1993 does not extend to the State of Jammu & Kashmir. The State Government has, however, set up its own State Backward Classes Commission.

The State Government has provided reservation to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (other than Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) as per the details below:-

- (i) Weak and under privileged classes (Social Castes) 2%
- (ii) Residents of Areas adjoining Actual Line of Control 3%
- (iii) Resident of Backward Areas 20%

Details of reservation provided to OBCs including the number of postslying vacant and the number of posts likely to be filled up are maintained by the State Government.
