**Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the number of new colleges approved by the Government to be set up in Delhi during the current year alongwith the location thereof;
- (b) the courses approved to be taught in these colleges;
- (c) the names of colleges where technical courses are proposed to be taught alongwith other courses;
- (d) whether the Government have also received any application from the private organisations for opening of private colleges;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) the time by which then approval is likely to be accorded to these colleges?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. MURLIMANO HAR JOSHI)

(a) to (f): The Government of National Capital Territory(NCT) of Delhi as well as the University of Delhi has not approved setting up of any college in Delhi during the current years.

The Government of NCT of Delhi, however, have granted no objection certificate to 19 colleges on the basis of application received from them for their affiliation with Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University in respect of courses like BBA,BCA,MBA < MC A,LLB etc. The Indraprastha University has started processing affiliation of all these colleges in accordance with the norms prescribed for this purpose by the University/ Government of NCT of Delhi.
