(a) to (c) No, Sir. The BIFR sanctioned revival scheme of BSCL does noprovide for revival of the company's Jellingham Fabrication Yard of Offshore Project at Nandigram. However, as a gesture of goodwill the Government of India have extended VRS benefits to the employees of the unit instead of retrenchment compensation.
