(a) & (b): With a view to curbing the activities of unregistered recruiting agents who include in cheating of emigrants, detailed guidelines have been issued to the various State Governments for issuing necessary instructions right upto the level of police stations for keeping a strict vigil on the activities of such agencies and for registration of cases against those found guilty. As and when any such case is bought to the notice of the Central Government, the same is referred to the concerned police authorities for necessary action.
