Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI BABU LAL MARANDI)

(a) The Ministry has not received any such proposal from Government of Punjab for getting forest clearance under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. However, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab had met Minister, Environment & Forests to discuss the issue.

The State has held only a prior consultation with the Government of India for preparing a proposal seeking approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 from the Central Government.
