- (a & b) India and Russia have not signed an agreement to expand cooperation in the field of nuclear sciences. However, an MoU for cooperation in Science & Technology has been signed between the Department of Science & Technology, Government of India and Russian Research Institute (Kurchatov Institute) of Russian Federation.
- (c & d) The MoU does not have any specific provision for exchange of nuclear scientists.
