**Cases Registered by Women Cell of  
Delhi Police**

2769. SHRI NARAIN SINGH CHAUDHARI: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of cases registered by the Women Cell of the Delhi Police during the last six months;

(b) the persons arrested in this regard; and

(c) the steps taken to make it more efficient?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI M.M. JACOB): (a) 191 cases have been registered on the recommendation of the Crime (W) Cell, in various Police Stations of Delhi during the last six months i.e. from 11.9.91 to 29.2.92.

(b) 339 persons have been arrested in 191 cases.

9c) Amongst the steps taken to make it more efficient are enlisting the help of counselors/psychiatrists, involvement of voluntary organisations in the working of the Cell and proper training of the staff in gender sensitization, transactional analysis and in investigation of cases.

**Incidents of Infiltration in Jammu and Kashmir**

2773. SHRI RATILAL VARMA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of incidents of infiltration which occurred in Jammu and Kashmir during the last three months, month-wise; and

(b) the details of the soldiers and citizens killed in the process, separately?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI M.M. JACOB): (a) In December, 1991, six incidents of infiltration have been reported. In January and February, 1992, only one incident of infiltration of terrorist group on the line of control came to notice.

(b) No Security force personnel was killed in the incidents involving infiltration of the terrorist groups. A total of 15 terrorists were killed and two arrested near the line of control in December, 1991. In January, and February 1992, four terrorists were killed and one arrested near the line of control.
