**Villages Under Integrated Tribal  
Development Project' In Gujarat and  
Uttar Pradesh**

Will the Minister of WELFARE be pleased to state the details of village selected under 'Integrated Tribal Development Project' in Gujarat and Uttar Pradesh?

MINISTER OF WELFARE (SHRI SITARAM KESRI): There are 4835 villages in 9 ITDPs in Gujarat covering an area of 23947 sq. Kms. with a total population of 4813582 out of which ST population is 3370391. These 9 ITDPs are located in 9 districts of Gujarat.

Uttar Pradesh has only one ITDP covering 41 villages with an area of 9936.77 Sq. Kms. with a total population of 22431, out of which tribal population is 16980. There is only one district in Uttar Pradesh which covers one ITDP only.

**Development of High Yielding Variety  
of Paddy**

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Agricultural Scientists of the Indian Agriculture Research Institute, New Delhi have developed a high yielding variety of paddy by using modern and conventional methods;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the areas identified for the cultivation of this variety of paddy; and

(d) the steps taken to popularise this variety of paddy?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI K.C. LENKA): (a) and (b). Yes Sir, A high yielding

variety, Pusa Basmati-1, was released in 1989.

(c) Punjab, Haryana, Western Uttar Pradesh and Delhi.

(d) Quality seed of this variety is multiplied and popularised by the National and State Seed Corporations. The seed is also being distributed under the schemes of Integrated Programme for Rice Development (IRDP) and supply of minikits.

#### **Agricultural Production**

2692. SHRIMATI VASUNDHARA RAJE: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government propose to increase agricultural production during Eighth Five Year Plan period;

(b) if so, the strategies proposed to be adopted for increasing agricultural production;

(c) the aid and assistance proposed to be given to Rajasthan to promote agriculture;

(d) the scheme submitted by the Government of Rajasthan to the Union Government for the promotion of agriculture; and

(e) the steps taken by the Government to provide adequate Central assistance to Rajasthan to promote agriculture?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The strategies proposed for increasing agricultural production during the Eighth Five Year Plan include (i) adoption of latest technology and its implementation quickly; (ii) following need based research recommendations; (iii) timely and need based supply of agricultural inputs; (iv) improvement in agricultural productivity in

the dryland belts; (v) acceleration of agricultural growth in the eastern region; (vi) implementation of effective programmes of diversification of cropping pattern; (vii) promotion of scientific post-harvest management of horticulture produce; (viii) acceleration of agricultural and plantation exports and import substitution of selected commodities; (ix) diversification of agricultural and acceleration of agrobased rural activities covering sericulture, fish-farming, poultry, animal husbandry, agriculture and silvi pasture systems.

(c) The aid and assistance proposed to be given to Rajasthan to promote the agriculture during the Eighth Five Year Plan has not yet been decided.

(d) No, Sir.

(e) Does not arise in view of the reply given in part (c) above.

#### **Extradition treaties with US and Canada**

(a) whether the Government propose to initiate talks on extradition treaties with US and Canada; and

(a) An extradition treaty with Canada was signed in February, 1987 and ratified in May the same year. The US-UK extradition treaty of 1939, which was acceded to on behalf of India in 1942 remains enforced between India and the US.
