827. SHRI UTTAMSINGH PAWAR: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government have entered into an agreement with PGS Ocean Bottom Seismic, a Norweagian Company for a dimensional Ocean bottom cable technique seismic survey over Mumbai High:
 - (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the project is likely to be completed?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI JANESHWAR MISHRA): (a) and (b) ONGC has awarded a contract to M/s. PGS OBS, Norway on 20.6.1997 for 3D acquisition, processing and interpretation work in the Mumbai High at a value of US\$ 49.73 million.

(c) The project is to be completed by 31.10.98.

Conditions of National Highways in Punjab

828. SHRI SUKHBIR SINGH BADAL: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government are aware of the poor condition of the National Highways passing through Faridkot district of Punjab particularly Dabwali-Malout section due to the water logging and lack of repair; and
- (b) if so, the steps taken by the Government to retrieve the situation by providing immediate assistance for the repair, expansion and maintenance of these roads?

THE MINISTER OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI T.G. VENKATRAMAN): (a) and (b) The Government is aware of settlement of certain stretches of National Highways between Dabwali to Malout & Bhatinda to Malout. The causes of settlement are being investigated for taking suitable permanent remedial measures. Regular maintenance is being done and the NHs are being kept in traffic worthy conditions within available resources.

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI JANESHWAR MISHRA) : (a) The Govt. already has a policy on gas utilisation.

(b) The present policy provides for allocation of gas according to imputed economic value of natural gas use subject to preference for the power and fertiliser sectors. It also provides for the extraction of higher value components like C2/C3 and LPG from natural gas wherever possible.

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI SRIKANTA JENA):
(a) No foreign assistance has been provided through Deptt. of Tourism, Government of India.

- (c) The Overseas Economic Co-operation Fund, Japan has extended soft loan assistance for infrastructure development along identified Buddhist circuit in U.P. & Bihar and Conservation and Tourism Development Project, Ajanta & Ellora in Maharashtra.

The places covered in U.P. include Sarnath, Kushinagar Piprahwa and Sravasti and the places covered in Bihar are Bodhgaya, Nalanda, Rajgir and Vaishali

The World Tourism Organisation and United Nations Development Programme have extended assistance for developing a Strategy for Environmentally Sustainable Tourism in Andamans.

Direct Flights between Mangalore and some Middle-East Countries

832. SHRI V. DHANANJAYA KUMAR: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken a decision to operate direct flight between Mangalore and some of the countries in the Middle-East; and
 - (b) since when the flight operations will commence?

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI C.M. IBRAHIM): (a) and (b) Measures are being taken to set up Customs and Immigration facilities at Mangalore Airport for direct international services to Middle-East countries. No definite time frame can be indicated at this stage for commencement of actual operations.

By-pass at Namakkal, Tamil Nadu

833. SHRI K. KANDASAMY: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any proposal to lay a Bypass Road at Namakkal Municipal Town with the coordination of Tamil Nadu Government;
 - (b) if so, the details thereof;

- (d) whether any land/engineering survey was made in this regard; and
 - (e) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI T.G. VENKATRAMAN): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The construction of Namakkal Bypass could not be taken up due to budgetory constraints of this Ministry. However, it is being taken up on B.O.T. (Build, Operate and Transfer) basis.

(c) to (e) The land acquisition for this purpose is in advanced stage of completion.
