STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 673 TO BE ANSWERED ON 12th MAY, 2005 REGARDING OIL SECTOR REFORMS.

(a) to (c): The scope for improving Asian markets for petroleum and petroleum products was discussed during the first Round Table of Asian Ministers on regional cooperation in the oil & gas economy held in New Delhi on 6th January, 2005 and attended by Ministers from India, Iran, Japan, Malaysia, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, UAE and Kuwait, besides representation from China and Korea. The issue requires careful study and detailed consideration with a view to identifying broad policy parameters that might require further inter-Governmental deliberation. The inaugural address of the Chairman and the statement by the Chairman setting out the draft conclusions of the conference, which, inter alia, deal with the question of a well-prepared Asian oil and petroleum products market, are attached.
