(a) to (e): A new Foreign Trade Policy is under formulation and would be announced in August, 2004. No Advisory Group has been constituted by the Government as yet. The new Policy would focus on thrust areas which include agriculture. The New Foreign Trade Policy is aimed at boosting exports, including agricultural exports and creating additional employment.
