ALLOCATION TO STATES UNDER AIBP

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

(a) the total amount of budgetary allocation made to States under Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP) during each of the last three years, State-wise;

(b) whether any allocation made under the programme during 2005-06; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI JAI PRAKASH NARAYAN YADAV)

(a) There is no budgetary allocation made to the States under the Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP). However, Central Loan Assistance (CLA) under AIBP is provided to the States on the basis of yearly ceiling fixed for the State as a whole by the Planning Commission during Annual Plan discussion of the States. A Statement showing state-wise ceiling of CLA under AIBP for the last three years is enclosed as Annexure.

(b) & (c) There is a budget allocation of Rs. 4800 crore for AIBP for the year 2005-06. As the Annual Plan discussions of the States are not concluded, the Planning Commission has not finalized the State-wise ceiling for CLA.
