(a) to (d): The Government is examining the issue of introducing downlinking policy to regulate satellite TV Channels which are uplinked from other countries and are down linked in India for public viewership. No time frame can be indicated for finalizing the guidelines.

Presently, there is no restriction on downlinking of signals of Satellite TV Channels which are uplinked from abroad and downlinked in India for public viewership.
