PASSENGER TRAIN BETWEEN MEERUT-DELHI ROUTE

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has made any assessment in regard to the total number of passengers commuting daily between Meerut-Delhi route and number of trains needed on the said route;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the number of requests/representation received for increase in passenger trains on this route; and
- (d) the corrective measures taken/to be taken in this regard?

Answer

(a) to (d): At present, 18 trains from Delhi to Meerut and 19 trains from Meerut to Delhi are available for the travelling public. These are considered adequate for the traffic offering in this section. Some representations were received. These were examined but not found feasible for implementation due to operational and resource constraints.
