- (a) whether any proposal for controlling Kamliya pest in some districts of Madhya Pradesh is pending with the Union Government;
- (b) if so, the action being taken thereon; and
- (c) by when this proposal is likely to be cleared and budget provided therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI KANTI LAL BHURIA)

(a)to(c): A proposal for control of `Kamlia` insect had been received from the Government of Madhya Pradesh. The Government of Madhya Pradesh had been requested to clarify certain components of their proposal and also to recast the same as per the technical observations communicated to them. The Government of Madhya Pradesh had not, however, submitted their revised proposal accordingly. In any case, funds required for control of this pest have been provided under the Integrated Scheme of Oilseeds, Pulses, Oil Palm and Maize and Macro Management Scheme of the Government of India which can be made use of by the Government of Madhya Pradesh.
