VELU) (a) & (b): No new rail projects falling fully/partly in the State of Tamil Nadu have been included in the budget 2005-06. Following new surveys falling fully/partly in the State of Tamil Nadu have been included in the budget 2005-06:-New line from Erode to Palani via Dharapuram (115 kms) New line from Mayiladuturai to Karaikal via Tirukadeyur, Taramgambadi & Tirunallar (35 kms) New line from Satyamangalam to Mettur via Anthiyur (75 kms) New line from Chennai to Cuddalore via Mahabalipuram & Pondicherry (71 kms) Gauge conversion of Madurai-Bodinayakkanur (90 kms) These surveys would be taken up once the Budget is passed by the Parliament.
