BSNL has planned to provide Digital Satellite Phone Terminals (DSPTs) in 465 remote villages of Jammu and Kashmir including 92 remote villages of Ladakh area in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement signed between the office of the Universal Service Obligation

(USO) Fund and BSNL.
