(d) the details of the issues discussed and the decisions arrived at in the meeting of Naxalite affected States held in Raipur recently;

(e) whether the Government proposes to hold talks with some Naxalite Organisations;

(f) if so, the details thereof;

(g) whether the Government had incurred expenditure in order to assist the Naxalite and Terrorist affected States to establish peace in the country; and

(h) if so, the details of the expenditure incurred during each of the last three years and thereafter, State-wise?

(a) & (b) : Some reports about naxalites having links with some of the extremist groups have come to the notice of the Government.

(c) : The details of Naxalite incidents reported, casualties of civilians, security personnel and property damaged in the last three years are as under :

The important decisions taken in this meeting inter-alia include preparation of Action Plans by States to neutralize the naxal threat, undertaking of anti-naxalite operations across the State bordering etc.

(e) & (f) : The Central Government has adopted a multi-pronged strategy to tackle the problem of naxalism which inter-alia includes having a peace dialogue by the affected States, wherever feasible, with the naxal groups which are willing to shun violence.

(g) & (h) : To enable the 9 badly affected States to undertake more effective anti-naxalite action, the Ministry of Home Affairs has been administering the Security Related Expenditure (SRE) Scheme.

The expenditure reimbursed to the naxal affected States during the last three years is as under :
