Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited has prepared a massive expansion plan involving a sum of Rs. 80,000 crores to triple its subscriber base over the next three years as reported in the 'Hindu' dated April 9, 2005;
- (b) if so, the facts thereof;
- (c) the investment proposed to be made in rural India out of the said investment plan to clear the backlog, State-wise; and
- (d) the time by which the telephone connections will be made available on demand in rural areas?

Answer

(a) & (b) BSNL, has prepared a plan for adding 77 million lines over the next three years to its present subscriber base of 46.9 million as on 31.03.2005. The year-wise addition in subscriber base has been planned as below:
