- (a) & (b): Government has recently announced some projects in Maharashtra under National Highway Development Project Phase III on Build, Operate & Transfer (BOT) basis for 11 stretches on six National Highways (NH No.3,4,6,9,17 and 50) for total length of 959 kms.

- (d): The selections of projects on BOT basis are based on the potential viability assessed on the basis of traffic intensity vis-Ã -vis project cost etc.
