Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of the projects completed so far under the Golden Quadrilateral Project in the country, State-wise particularly in Tamil Nadu:
- (b) whether the Government has reviewed the progress of the said projects;
- (c) if so, the reasons for slow progress; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to complete the projects within the stipulated period?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K. H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) Out of the 5846 kms aggregate length of various National Highways taken up under the Golden Quadrilateral Project in the country, 4696 kms have been completed so far. State-wise status is annexed. In the State of Tamil Nadu, an aggregate length of 341 kms of various National Highways is under the Golden Quadrilateral Project, out of which 322 kms have been completed.
- (b) Yes, Sir. The progress of the project is reviewed periodically at various levels.
- (c) The progress of works has been affected in some States due to the problems associated with delay in land acquisition and shifting of utilities, poor performance of some contractors, delay in forest/environment clearances etc.
- (d) The following steps have been taken for speedy completion of the project.
- i) To expedite the acquisition of land and shifting of utilities etc, nodal officers at the level of Commissioner/Secretary/Principal Secretary of State Governments have been nominated. The regular follow up meetings are held with the State Government officials and with the nodal officers.
- ii) Non-performing contractors have been debarred for future projects.
- iii) A Committee of Secretaries has been constituted to resolve the inter-ministerial issues and problems with the State Governments.
