- (a): Five such State Highways have been declared as National Highways (NHs) in February, 2004 in the State of Rajasthan.
- (b): Total length of these newly declared National Highways is 990.0 km which are located in Rajasthan State.

(c)and(d): The notification for entrustment of these National Highways was issued on 29th October, 2004. Development and Maintenance of National Highways is a continuous process and projects are taken up depending upon the availability of funds and inter-se-priorities.
