- (a): A World Bank assisted Capacity Building Project on Food and Drugs is in operation since 18.10.2003 for a period of five years. The project envisages the Upgradation of food & Drugs Control infrastructure at the Central and State Level by way of civil works, provision of equipments, training of food and drug regulatory personnel and personnel from the concerned industry and initiatives for information, education and communication in these areas.
