(a)to(c): Famines signify extreme scarcity of food. There is no famine in the country. Following aberrations in the South-West monsoon, however, drought-like conditions have appeared in certain States. Additional assistance so far extended for drought relief during the year 2004-2005 to such states is as under:-
