(a) to (c): No such proposal has been received from Government of Assam. However, a proposal for grant of permission for establishment of new medical college at Panikhaiti, Kamrup in Assam by Down Town Charity Trust, Guwahati has been received. The proposal has been sent to Medical Council of India for evaluation. The clearance of the proposal depends on the fulfillment of qualifying criteria prescribed in the Regulations of Medical Council of India, availability of infrastructural facilities for running of MBBS course and recommendation of Medical Council of India thereon.
