- (a)&(b) Devdasi system is prevailing in the temples of Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra and Karnataka.
- (c)&(d) The States of Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra and Karnataka already have Acts on prohibition and dedication of Devdasis. Under these acts whoever performs, promotes, abets, takes part in dedication ceremony is liable for punishment. Their harassment is taken care under Immoral Traffic Prevention Act, 1956 and Indian Penal Code.
