## Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is a long pending proposal for construction of Pune-Nasik railway line;

(b) if so, whether any survey was also conducted in this regard;

(c) if so, the details thereof and the expenditure incurred therein;

(d) the reasons for not constructing the Pune-Nasik rail line inspite of completion of survey long back;

(e) the decision of the Government in regard to the construction of this rail line in the coming years; and

(f) the time by which the final decision is likely to be taken and the construction work are likely to be started?

## Answer

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU)

(a) to (f): The survey for Pune-Nasik new rail line was completed in 2000-01. As per the survey, cost of construction of this 266 km long line was assessed as Rs.1044 crore. Keeping in view heavy throwforward of on-going projects and acute constraints of resources it has not been found feasible to consider the proposed line.
