### Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the current Doctor-Patient ratio in the country, State-wise;

(b) the Doctor-Patient ratio as suggested by the WHO;

(c) the measures contemplated by the government to achieve this ratio;

(d) the measures planned to achieve uniform Doctor-Patient ratio throughout the country; and

(e) the ratio of population MBBS seats, available in the Medical Colleges, State-wise?

# Answer

#### THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. PANABAKA LAKSHMI)

(a) to (d): The doctor-patient ratio varies from case to case depending upon various factors like the type of disease, nature of specialization, type of patient care required viz. indoor/outdoor. However, as per the figures obtained from the Medical Council of India, the allopathic doctor-population ratio at present works out to 1:1722.

Apart from this, there are about 6,94,712 registered Medical Practitioners of Indian Systems of Medicine and Homoeopathy. Taken together, the Doctor-Population ratio comes to more than 128 per lac population (1:781). In addition, there are 233 Medical Colleges with annual intake of 26,192 students as on 25.04.05. According to the Medical Council of India, there are sufficient number of doctors to take care of services all over the country including rural areas.
