- (d) if so, the details thereof alongwith the achievements made in this regard?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.86 BY SHRI VIJOY KRISHNA, SHRIMATI NIVEDITA MANE, REGARDING DECLINE IN EMPLOYMENT GENERATION, FOR REPLY ON 12.7.2004.

- a&b) Estimates of employment and unemployment in the country are obtained through quinquennial labour force surveys conducted by National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO). As per the surveys conducted by NSSO during 1993-94 and 1999-2000, estimated employment in the country on usual status basis has gone up from approximately 37.4 crore in 1993-94 to 39.7 crore in 1999-2000. Employment figures since 2000 onwards are not yet available.
- c&d) During the Tenth Plan, 5 crore employment opportunities are proposed to be generated. Out of this, about 3 crore employment opportunities will be from usual growth process and the remaining 2 crore through special employment generation schemes with special emphasis on Agriculture, Irrigation, Agro Forestry, Small and Medium Enterprises, Information and Communication Technology, Tourism and other services. Achievements so far made during the Tenth Plan in this regard would be available after the 2004-05 quinquennial survey by NSSO is completed.
