- (a) the details of current policy of reservation for OBCs for admission to Medical Colleges for MBBS, Post -Graduatge courses and Paramedical courses;
- (b) whether it is uniform for all the Central Government Institutions;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefore?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. PANABAKA LAKSHMI)

(a) to (d): The admission to MBBS, Postgraduate and paramedical courses in medical colleges, including the policy of reservation, is governed by the respective State Governments/Universities/Examining Authorities/Institutions. The Central Government has not provided for reservation in admission to medicine and para-medical courses for OBCs in the Central Government Institutions.
