Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of the schemes sponsored by the Centre to provide health care to the poor people;
- (b) whether these schemes are not being implemented effectively in some States;
- (c) if so.the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Union Government has taken any steps to monitor the implementation of such schemes; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (DR.ANBUMANI RAMADOSS)

- (a): Most of the schemes of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare are meant to cater to the health needs of the poor people. These include the schemes supporting public health care infrastructure, interventions under Reproductive & Child Health (RCH) Programme, National Disease Control Programme, Janani Surakasha Yojana, Health Minister's Discretionary Grant and Rashtriya Arogya Nidhi.
- (b) & (c): The implementation of the Schemes varies across States mainly due to weak health infrastructure, systemic and governance issues.
- (d) & (e): The Government has recently launched a National Rural Health Mission. The Mission shall focus on 18 States to improve the implementation of existing schemes and programmes by strengthening primary healthcare services and by undertaking systemic reforms.
