## Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

(a) whether there has been a continuous fall in the prices of steel for the last two months;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor;

(c) whether the sale of steel in the local market has been at its highest during the last year; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

## Answer

MINISTER OF CHEMICALS & FERTILISERS AND MINISTER OF STEEL (SHRI RAM VILAS PASWAN)

(a) Yes, Sir. The steel prices have declined since May 2005 and the trend has continued in July 2005.

(b) The domestic steel prices are pegged with the steel prices in the international market. There has been a softening of steel prices in the international market and therefore the prices in the domestic market have also declined.

(c)&(d): The consumption of finished steel during 2004-05 was 33.40 million metric tonnes (provisionally), showing an impressive growth of 7.86% over the consumption during 2003-04. The higher consumption is attributable to strong domestic demand for iron & steel arising due to growth in the industrial sector in general and in the construction activity in particular.
