(a) & (b) Sir, in Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL), Army Personnel are allowed to register their application for a telephone connection under priority category, i.e. Non-Own Your Telephone (Non-OYT) Special category, provided they do not have any telephone working in their name. In Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited (MTNL), telephone connections to all categories of persons including army personnel are available on demand.
