(a): Government of Punjab intends to develop Mohali as an IT Hub and the proposed investment of Rs 200 Crore is announced by the State Government is aimed at upgradation of infrastructure a t Mohali for industry in general and IT, ITES, Electronics & Communications, BioTech and other Hi-Tech industry in particular.

(b): The Government of India has given in principle clearance to an IT based Special Economic Zone on Mohali.

Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) an autonomous society under Government of India, Department of Information Technology has set up its Centre with an investment of Rs 5 Crores at Mohali to provide statutory and High Speed Data Communication services to the software industry.
