- (a) & (b): The State Government of Maharashtra has requested for enhancing the storage capacity of FCI in the districts of Dondaicha, Dhula, Jalgaon, Jalana, Parbahani, Latur, Khamgaon, Parall and Nanded and for opening of additional depot/FCI Base depots in each district to minimize the transport cost.
- (c), (d) & (e): The Government of Maharashtra have sent a proposal for early commencement of procurement, both for Kharif and Rabi seasons, from 1st September and 1st March respectively. This request has been agreed to.
