- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been entered into between the Indian Railways and the Karnataka State Tourism Development Corporation (KSTDC) for running a luxury tourist train in the Karnataka sector.
- (c): The train is to be commissioned by the KSTDC. No time frame has been given by them.
- (d): No, Sir.
- (e) & (f): Do not arise.
