(a) to (c) According to the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) a joint meeting under the aegis of Indiaclen and Chinaclen was held on traditional remedies for Diabetes and Hepatitis. Further meetings to identify the medicinal plants for these areas are yet to take place. In the field of reproductive health also need has been felt for cooperation between the two countries for prevention of reproductive tract infections as well as drugs and devices for population control.
