- (a) the present stage of the second reactor of the Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project which will generate 1,000 MWe and is to be commissioned in September, 2007;
- (b) whether Russia has agreed to speed up the supply of equipment and working documentation for the project;
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE(SHRI PRITHVIRAJ CHAVAN):

- (a) The second reactor (Unit 2 of 1000 MWe) of Kudankulam Atomic Project is scheduled for completion by December 2008 and the work is proceeding as per schedule.
- (b)&(c) The manufacturing of equipment in Russia is according to the approved completion dates of the project. Specific advancements of deliveries of equipment, on a case to case basis, are requested depending upon their urgency at site for advancing the project completion.
