- (a) the number of extra flights operated by both public and private sector airlines during the Tsunami Crisis for rescue works; and
- (b) the extent to which the public sector airlines have provided help in the rescue works during Tsunami crisis?

Answer

- (a):- Public Sector Airlines operated 139 relief flights from 27.12.2004 to 17.1.2005 and Private Sector Airlines operated 35 relief flights from 27.12.2004 to 17.1.2005 during the Tsunami crisis for rescue works.
- (b):- Public sector airlines airlifted :
- 1. 8448 adults and 245 infants from Port Blair to mainland.
- 2. 5067 relief personnel and Para-military personnel for relief opeerations to Port Blair.
- 3. 358.26 tons of relief cargo to Port Blair.
