(a) & (b) Train-wise figures of profitability, earnings and expenditure are not separately maintained. However, on an overall basis, Railways are making losses on passenger services (excluding Electric Multiple Unit). The losses incurred on this account during the last three years are as under:

Year Losses (Rs. in crore)

2000-2001 3849.82

2001-2002 4339.07
2002-2003 4245.68
