- (a) whether the Government proposes to integrate various samadhis on the bank of Yamuna river in Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details of the plan so envisaged and the time by which it is going to make the plan effective;
- (c) the amount of expenditure involved therein; and
- (d) the details of facilities proposed to be provided for VIPs and the general tourists visiting Delhi?

(a)to(d): It has been decided to redevelop/upgrade the entire samadhis Complex. A concept Committee has been constituted on 27.1.2005 to prepare an integrated Concept Plan to make the Complex aesthetically and functionally better befitting the sanctity of the place and to meet the requirements of visitors/tourists to the Complex. An amount of Rs.3.25 crores has been approved so far for the said upgradation.
