REPAIRING OF ROADS IN DELHI

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether new sewerage pipes have been laid down in various parts of Delhi particularly in Subhas Nagar, New Delhi in the recent past;
- (b) if so, whether the roads have not been repaired after laying of the sewerage pipes;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the action taken for repairing the roads expeditiously?

Answer

(a)to(d): The Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) has informed that recently new pipelines have been laid by Delhi Jal Board (DJB) at various locations in Subhas Nagar, New Delhi. The road cuts made by DJB are repaired by Katcha patch regularly. During the rainy seasons it is not possible to repair the roads by bituminous work. The preparatory action for repairing the roads by bituminous work after the rainy season has already been initiated by MCD.
