(a)-(d) Officials from India and the United States have held discussions on diverse issues on the non-proliferation agenda. The last round of these discussions was held in Washington on 31 March 2004. Discussions have been held with the US side on the Proliferation Security Initiative (PSI). In these discussions, Government has been guided by considerations related to legitimacy of actions under the Proliferation Security Initiative and their grounding in international law.
